Fundraising Director




SENIORS here is your opportunity to tell Delwood what you would like for the community to do for you!

Community Leagues do this through organizing recreational, education and sport programming, hosting community parties and events, developing amenities such as spray parks, playgrounds, sports courts, community gardens and community league halls, and by being the voice of the community when it comes to civic matters that impact your neighbourhood.

Some **benefits** available, regardless of which community league is yours, include:




