Fundraising Director needed immediately

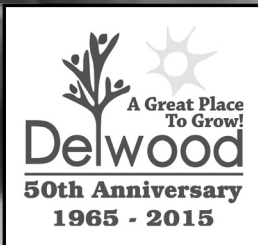

Manager — Katrina Huhtala

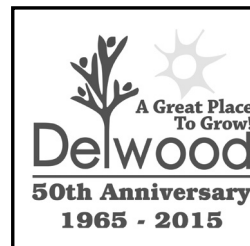
