The City of Edmonton is nearly done its latest consultation on the collector renewal for 132 Avenue between Fort Road and 127 Street has been chosen for collector renewal with construction anticipated to start in 2023.

## About the Project

Collector Renewal on 132 Avenue will rehabilitate the road, add missing sidewalk links, replace street lights, sidewalks and curb and gutters. Improving how people walk, bike, drive and gather in and around 132 Avenue will also be explored.


