City of Edmonton Garbage Collection

Your New Carts

All single-unit and some multi-unit homes will receive:

- ◆ Garbage cart - large (240L) default size or small (120L) by special request
- ◆ Food scraps cart - 120L
- ◆ Food scraps pail for in-home use
- ◆ Information package
- ◆ New collection schedule

Large (240L) Garbage Cart

The large garbage cart is the default size.

Small (120L) Garbage Cart

A small garbage cart is available for households that produce less waste and will save you almost \$4/month.

Assisted Waste Collection

The City's Waste Services offers an assisted waste collection service for customers who have difficulty getting their waste to the curb or lane.

Two new service options are available:

- ◆ **Option #1:** for residents who are able to put waste in their carts but require the City to set out the carts at the curb for collection, then return the carts to their storage location after they are emptied
- ◆ **Option #2:** for residents who need the City to take waste from their door, place it in their carts, set the carts out for collection, and return the carts to their storage location once they are emptied

Cart **delivery** is currently scheduled for: **May 9, 2021** and **May 29, 2021**
Cart **collection** starts the week of: **June 1, 2021**
