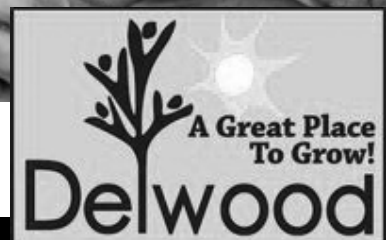

Delwood Hall Renovation Update

There have been some steps forwards and some step backwards on our Hall project, but the committee is happy to report that the Hall Renovation is back on track.

Late in 2016, we parted ways with our former architectural firm. The committee searched for and hired a project manager, Randy Darr. Randy has lots of experience in projects of a similar scope as Delwood Hall. The committee revised the project timeline and started a search for a new architect. In February 2017, Croy Yee was awarded our project and went right to work on concepts in time for the Delwood Community League AGM on March 20.



At the AGM, two concepts were presented, discussed and voted on. It was a tight vote, but a decision was made and we now have a concept to work towards.

In the same week, applications have been put forward to the City to keep us moving towards construction in the spring and summer of 2018.

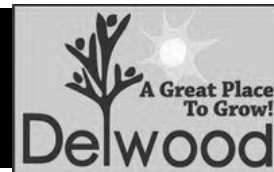
