Delwood Soccer

Is being part of a team important to you? Does building self-esteem in young people give you a sense of accomplishment? Do you care about your neighbours and having a safe community?

If you've answered yes to any of these questions, we urge you to consider becoming Delwood's soccer director.

Most of us know that team sports are about so much more than their physical benefits and "keeping the little ones busy." Players who have positive sports mentors when they're young are more likely to seek effective role models throughout their life. They will do better at school and work because they understand that everyone has a contribution to make. Players understand their impact on others, which leads to a sense of responsibility to help the people around them.

Team sports provide athletes, and their families, with a natural community. A number of players don't go to school in Delwood, but playing soccer has helped them, and their parents, to grow friendships with

others in our neighbourhood that continue long after their playing days are over. When people know each other, they care about each other. They look out for one another and monitor what the kids are up to, and that helps our community be safer. Soccer parents work the bingos that support our hall expenses and volunteer at events that bring our community together. Many of these positive outcomes don't happen when our kids have to play with other communities because ours can't field teams.

You can be the person to build our community, to be a mentor and keep kids focused on positive relationships and activities, and to lead a great team of fantastic coaches, committed parents, and enthusiastic players. Delwood's soccer director is supported by committed and experienced board members who will help you with every step, and by league training and resources. You don't need soccer experience, but good organizational skills would be helpful.





