Ensuring the safety of our community is paramount, and it is important that pet owners do their part.

Pet owners are completely responsible for their pet's behaviour. Prevent harm to others and others' property through good training and using a leash.

Pets are required by law to be on leash when outside of the home or enclosed backyard, with the exception of designated off-leash parks, school yards and community parkland in Delwood are not designated off-leash areas.

Leashes attached to trees or anchored into the ground and left unattended must be adequately secure.

Driving with pets in the back of trucks is unsafe and illegal. Ensure your animals are secure inside the cabin of the vehicle.

Leaving pets unattended in a hot vehicle for any amount of time is dangerous. Vehicle temperatures can climb to surprising values, even when the temperature outside is mild.

Animal waste on both private and public land must be picked up promptly.

To report concerns or an incident, call 311 and document as much information as possible including where it happened, when it happened, and a description of the others involved in the incident.

Fines for non-compliance with the Animal Licensing and Control Bylaw range from \$100 to \$10,000.


